

REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPATION CREDIT

A willingness to do all that it takes to mount a traditionally excellent CWA Players production should always be a given. However, with the diversity of positions in any given production, here are the clear standards of participation to earn an activity credit for participating in the fall or winter drama productions. (.5 credit for Fall and Winter. .25 credit for One-Acts)

REQUIREMENTS:

- Cast and crew must attend at least 3 rehearsals per week until the final three weeks of the production when attendance will be required every day.
- Cast and crew must attend all night-time rehearsals during the final week of the production. **(Bear in mind the School Rule that *all students must attend all classes in order to participate in after-school activities on any given day.*)**
- Cast and crew must attend the **TECH REHEARSAL (an all-day rehearsal the Saturday before the show opens)** and the **STRIKE (tearing down the set *immediately* following the final performance)**. Regardless of circumstances, these dates are mandatory.
- Rehearsals run from 3:30 till 5:30. I will often end rehearsals a little early, but please anticipate being in the theatre for the entire time.

Also, I fully understand that some absences are unavoidable but, because of the collaborative nature of the theatre, it is imperative that I know in advance if you are not going to be at rehearsal. If you are going to miss a rehearsal for any reason and your name is **not** going to be on Ms Kriese's list **you must let me know before noon of that day**. Call me directly at 620-8380. The repercussions for not doing this will not necessarily affect your activity credit, but it could cripple the trust that is needed for any given production.
