

## Citation Guidelines and Examples for MLA 7<sup>th</sup> Ed

Sources referenced in the paper are placed at the end, in either a Works Cited list or Bibliography, in alphabetical order with the author's last name first. If there is no author, the entry begins with the title of the article. For books, include, in this order: **Author(s) or Editor(s). Complete Title. Edition. Place of Publication: Name of Publisher, Date of Publication. Print.**
