**Project description:** You and your classmates are going to take a virtual trip to a Hispanic country. You will have the opportunity to make a travel portfolio with IMOVIE as you navigate your way through these beautiful countries. As you travel, you will be collecting images of the many sites you see as well as creating a digital narration of each place visited! You will be creating an I-MOVIE with images and your personal narration to share with your class, your friends and your family upon your return. Please follow carefully the guide below before you embark on this adventure!

¡A viajar.....! Your presentation should include a **minimum of 20 images**. One of your images must be a **map of the country you will visit**.

**PROJECT CHECKLIST:** You must include the following categories in your virtual trip:

- A map of the region
- Two museums
- Two churches or catedrales
- A historical site, such as ruins, archeological sites, castles, fortresses, palaces, etc.
- Three restaurants (one for each meal)
- Pictures of regional cuisines
- One national park or a famous beach.
- One geologic point of interest such as the rainforest, the mountains, reserves, lakes, volcanoes
- Picture of currency and an explanation of the current value.
- A flag of the country or countries visited
- Picture of people
- Current leader of the country
- An image of a school
- National, traditional or popular sport
- Image of a national passtime (bullfighting, flamenco, music, dance, art, etc)
- Anything else of interest (typical holiday celebrations, famous people, famous musicians, etc.)
- Un zócolo or a central plaza.
